Scholarship Availability

The Grant Sheridan Memorial Scholarship will be made available to the successful applicant after proof has been received that they are attending as a full-time student at a College, University, Trade or Vocational Program. Cheques will be made payable to the successful applicant. Scholarship winners may defer receipt of their award for a period no longer than 24 months, deferment requests must be submitted in writing and include an explanation.

Payment of Scholarship monies will be made after receipt of Grade 12 school transcripts and proof of registration, payment and acceptance to any of the above listed institutions along with course data.

Grant Sheridan Memorial Scholarship winner may defer receipt of their awards for a period no longer than two academic years.
